## **ORDER NO. 8**

## DENYING REQUEST FOR EXTENSION, WITHDRAWING ORDER NO. 5, AND SETTING DEADLINE TO RESPOND TO MOTION TO DISMISS

In Order No. 7 filed on January 24, 2022, the administrative law judge (ALJ) established January 27, 2022, as the deadline for Belknap, FP, Ltd. to file a signed, notarized copy of the affidavit attached to its petition for streamlined expedited release. On January 27, 2022, Belknap filed a request for extension stating, "Counsel for Petitioner just learned that the property has been sold and is currently working with the new landowner to obtain a signed affidavit."

On January 27, 2022, Marilee Special Utility District filed its opposition to the request for extension and moved to dismiss this proceeding under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 22.181(d)(8). Specifically, Marilee SUD argues that because Belknap no longer owns the property that is the subject of the petition, Belknap cannot satisfy the requirements of Texas Water Code § 13.2541 and, therefore, Belknap cannot state a claim for which relief may be granted.

The ALJ denies Belknap's motion for extension of time and withdraws Order No. 5 filed on December 7, 2021, which includes withdrawal of the ALJ's finding of administrative completeness of the petition and the procedural schedule therein. Responses to Marilee SUD's motion to dismiss, if any, must be filed by February 16, 2022.
