FINDING PETITION ADMINISTRATIVELY INCOMPLETE AND ESTABLISHING
AN OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the September 3, 2021 petition of A. J. Malone to amend Marilee Special Utility District’s water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Collin County by streamlined expedited release. On October 4, 2021, Commission Staff filed its recommendation on the administrative completeness of the petition.

The administrative law judge finds the petition administratively incomplete for the reasons described in the memorandum of Jolie Mathis, attached to Commission Staff’s recommendation.

The following procedural schedule applies for continued processing:
