ORDER NO. 4 GRANTING UNOPPOSED EXTENSION, REVISING DEADLINE, AND RESTYLING

This Order addresses Commission Staff's November 23, 2021 unopposed request to extend the deadline to file its supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness of the supplemented petition and notice, proposed procedural schedule, and request to restyle the first amended petition and supplement thereto.

I. Unopposed Extension

Counsel for Commission Staff states that additional time is needed to file a supplemental recommendation due to his unavailability during the week of November 29, 2021. Commission Staff represents that counsel for petitioner is not opposed to the request for extension.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) grants Commission Staff's unopposed request for extension. By December 8, 2021, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation on the sufficiency of the first amended petition and supplement thereto, notice, and propose a procedural schedule for continued processing. A new deadline for Marilee SUD to file a response to the first amended petition and supplement thereto will be established in a subsequent order.

II. Restyling

Commission Staff also requests that this docket be restyled. Specifically, on September 3, 2021, Clifton Van McKnight and Bryan Jeffery McKnight filed a petition for streamlined expedited release from Marilee SUD's water certificate of convenience and necessity number 10150. However, since the filing of the petition, the property at issue was sold to VPTM Cross Creek LB, LLC, which seeks to continue this proceeding as petitioner and filed a first amended petition to reflect such on October 6, 2021. On November 4, 2021, a supplement to the first amended petition was filed.

The ALJ grants Commission Staff's request and restyles this matter as reflected in this Order.
