**ORDER NO. 5
FINDING AMENDED PETITION ADMINISTRATIVELY INCOMPLETE
AND ESTABLISHING OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the October 6, 2021 amended petition and supplement to the amended petition filed by VPTM Cross Creek LB, LLC on October 6 and November 4, 2021, respectively.

On December 8, 2021, Commission Staff filed a supplemental recommendation regarding, among other things, the administrative completeness and notice sufficiency of the amended petition and supplement to the amended petition.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the petition administratively incomplete. Specifically, while VPTM Cross Creek included a certificate of service with its amended petition certifying that it sent a copy of the amended petition to Marilee SUD by electronic service on the day the petition was filed with the Commission, the amended petition did not include proof that a copy was also mailed to Marilee SUD via certified mail on the same day.

The following procedural schedule applies for continued processing:
