ORDER NO. 6 ABATING PROCEEDING

This Order addresses the December 20, 2021 motion to dismiss filed by Marilee Special Utility District. In its motion to dismiss, Marilee SUD asserts that Grayson County is not a qualifying county under Texas Water Code § 13.2541 and 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.245(h). Specifically, Marilee SUD asserts that the Texas Government Code requires that the population of Grayson County be measured by the 2010 federal census and that Grayson County is not a qualifying county under the 2010 federal census.

A similar question has been certified to the Commission in Docket No. 52556¹ and the Commission is set to consider the question at its January 27, 2022 open meeting.² Accordingly, the administrative law judge defers ruling on Marilee SUD's motion to dismiss and abates this proceeding while the certified issue is pending.
