COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

On September 8, 2021, E Real Estate, LLC (E Real Estate) filed a petition for streamlined expedited release from Marilee Special Utility District's (Marilee SUD) water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 10150 under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.2541(b) and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.245(h). E Real Estate asserts that the land to be released is at least 25 contiguous acres, is not receiving water service, and is located in Collin County, which is a qualifying county. On October 1, 2021 Marilee Special Utility District filed a motion to intervene. On November 4, 2021, December 13, 2021, February 18, 2022, April 4, 2022, June 15, 2022 and August 17, 2022, E Real Estate filed supplemental information.

On October 25, 2022, the administrative law judge filed Order No. 12 establishing a deadline of November 8, 2022 for the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission (Commission) to a second revised final recommendation that fully complies with all of the requirements of Order No. 10. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

Under 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Staff requires more time to review the applicant's filings as well as Docket No. 53037. Thus, Staff respectfully requests an extension to November 18, 2022.

II. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully requests that the deadline to file a second revised final recommendation that fully complies with all of the requirements of Order No. 10. be extended until November 18, 2022.
