**ORDER NO. 7**  
**DIRECTING COMMISSION STAFF TO SUBMIT A PROPOSED MAP AND**  
**CERTIFICATE**

In this matter, E Real Estate, LLC seeks streamlined expedited release from Marilee Special Utility District's water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) number 10150 in Collin County.

On February 3, 2022, Marilee SUD filed a response to the petition. On February 17, 2022, Commission Staff recommended that the petition be denied. Because it recommended denial, Commission Staff did not file a proposed map and certificate. On February 24, 2022, the petitioner filed a reply to Marilee SUD and Commission Staff. The reply includes an additional affidavit and photographs. Having reviewed the entirety of the record, the administrative law judge (ALJ) has concluded that the petitioner has met its burden of proof and the petition should be granted. The ALJ intends to issue a Proposed Order to that effect. Therefore, the ALJ directs Commission Staff to, by March 15, 2022, file a certificate and map on which it identifies the tract of land being released in relation to the CCN holder's certificated service area.
