ORDER NO. 3 FINDING PETITION ADMINISTRATIVELY INCOMPLETE, AND PROVIDING OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses the September 8, 2021 petition of E Real Estate, LLC to amend Marilee Special Utility District's water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Collin County by streamlined expedited release. The petitioner seeks the streamlined expedited release of a tract of land that lies within Marilee SUD's CCN number 10150. E Real Estate filed supplemental information on October 8, 2021 and November 4, 2021.

On December 8, 2021, Commission Staff filed its supplemental recommendation on the administrative completeness of the petition.

The administrative law judge finds the petition administratively incomplete for the reasons described in the memorandum of Jolie Mathis, attached to Commission Staff's recommendation.
