Expedited Release

If the Commission votes to adopt the revised proposed order in this proceeding and deny the petition of Central Frisco, Ltd., I recommend certain changes to the final order.

Finding of fact 22 should be incorporated into finding of fact 20 and then finding of fact 22 should be deleted. Finding of fact 21 should be deleted for accuracy.

- 20. On December 29, 2021, the CCN holder filed the affidavit of Eddy Daniel, engineer of record for the CCN Holder, attesting that the CCN holder maintains a 2½-inch waterline and two inative service connections, currently capable of being activated, within the bondaries of the tract of land on the east side.
- 21. The $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch line ends in two inactive meters.
- 22. Each of the two inactive meters are capable of being re-activated.

Additionally, finding of fact 26 should be modified for accuracy and a new finding of fact should be added after finding of fact 26 for completeness.

- 26. In her affidavit, Ms. Stout acknowledged the existence of the southern-most line and meter.
- XX. In her affidavit, Ms. Stout asserted that she and two other employees were unable to locate the northern-most meter after several attempts to locate it.

Finally, the Commission should delegate to the Office of Policy and Docket Management staff the authority to modify the order to conform to the Citation and Style Guide for the Public Utility Commission of Texas and to make other non-substantive changes to the order for such matters as capitalization, spelling, grammar, punctuation, style, correction of numbering, and readability.

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
