COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION ON ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS AND NOTICE

On September 8, 2021, Central Frisco LTD. (Central Frisco) filed a petition for expedited release from Marilee Special Utility District's (Marilee SUD) water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) number 10150 under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.2541 and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.245(h). Central Frisco asserts that the land to be released is at least 25 contiguous acres, is not receiving water service, and is located in Collin County, which is a qualifying county.

On September 9, 2021, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 1, establishing a deadline of October 8, 2021 for the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff) to file comments regarding the administrative completeness of the petition and notice. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS

Staff has reviewed the petition and, as detailed in the attached memorandum from Jolie Mathis, Infrastructure Division, recommends that the petition is administratively incomplete. Staff further recommends that Central Frisco be ordered to cure the deficiencies identified in Ms. Mathis' memorandum by November 8, 2021 and that Staff be given a deadline of December 8, 2021 to file a supplemental recommendation on the administrative completeness of the petition.

II. PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

In accordance with Staff's deficiency recommendation, Staff does not propose a procedural schedule for further processing of the docket at this time. Staff intends to propose a procedural schedule alongside a subsequent recommendation that the petition be found administratively complete.

Ш. **CONCLUSION**

For the reasons detailed above, Staff recommends that the petition be found administratively incomplete and that Central Frisco be ordered to file supplemental information to cure the deficiencies in the petition by November 8, 2021. Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order consistent with these recommendations.
