**ORDER NO. 6**  
**GRANTING EXTENSION AND ADOPTING NEW PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the parties’ motion, filed on May 19, 2022, to amend the procedural schedule. The parties request an extension of the procedural schedule due to a delay in preparation of the notice, but they did not include a proposed new procedural schedule or explain how much time they need.<sup>1</sup>

The administrative law judge grants the motion and adopts the following procedural schedule:

| Deadline for the petitioners to file proof of notice   | July 14, 2022 |
| Deadline for Commission Staff to make a recommendation on the sufficiency of notice and propose a procedural schedule for further processing | July 28, 2022 |
