On July 14, 2022, the City of Rockwall and Blackland Water Supply Corporation submitted Proofs of Notice to all customers and landowners within the areas to be decertified and, under separate cover, a copy of the notice and map sent to each customer/landowner. To confirm and clarify, the notices were provided to both customers and landowners within the areas subject to the joint petition, as required under Order No. 5, which established initial deadlines for mailing of notice to “each customer and landowner within the areas to be decertified” and for filing of the proof of notice, after specifically determining that such notice was appropriate under 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.245(d)(2).<sup>1</sup>
