ORDER NO. 9 FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING A PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of notice of the application of Blackland Water Supply Corporation and the City of Rockwall to decertificate portions of a portion of a certificate of convenience and necessity. The petitioners filed various proofs of notice and explanatory materials on July 14 and 27, August 22, and September 12, 2022. On July 28 and September 27, 2022, Commission Staff filed recommendations on the sufficiency of notice.

The administrative law judge finds the notice sufficient and establishes the following procedural schedule for continued processing of this docket:

Deadline for petitioners to file signed consent forms with the Commission	November 14, 2022

If no hearing is requested, deadline for Commission Staff to file a final recommendation on the application	November 30, 2022
If no hearing is requested, deadline for the parties to file joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law, and ordering paragraphs	December 15, 2022
