**ORDER NO. 6
DECLINING TO RULE ON DISCOVERY MOTION**

On March 2, 2022, GJGTEB Holdings, LLC served on Creedmoor-Maha Water Supply Corporation a first set of requests for information (RFIs). On March 22, 2022, Creedmoor-Maha filed an objection to the RFIs and requested that the administrative law judge enter an order striking GJGTEB's RFIs in their entirety.

The administrative law judge declines to rule on the motion. Consistent with prior rulings in streamlined expedited release cases,¹ there is no right to conduct discovery in such cases. If they wish to do so, the parties are free to engage in discovery on a voluntary basis. However, the ALJ cannot enforce the Commission's discovery rules in such cases.
