ORDER NO. 2
FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT,
AND ESTABLISHING AN OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the September 23, 2021 application of the Town of Lakeside and the City of Fort Worth for sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Tarrant County. On October 22, 2021, Commission Staff filed its recommendation on administrative completeness and notice.

The administrative law judge finds the application administratively incomplete and deficient. Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider an application filed until it makes a determination that the application is administratively complete. Thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

By November 22, 2021, the applicants must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies as described in the October 22, 2021 memorandum of Jolie Mathis. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed. The applicants must not issue notice until the application is deemed administratively complete.

By December 22, 2021, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
