COMMISSION STAFF'S MOTION TO DISMISS

On September 27, 2021, the City of Edinburg (Edinburg) filed an application to amend its certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Hidalgo County. Edinburg seeks approval to decertify a portion of North Alamo Water Supply Corporation's water CCN No. 10553 and amend to Edinburg's CCN No. 12106.

On March 7, 2022, the administrative law judge (ALJ) issued Order No. 4, establishing a deadline of March 4 for Edinburg to file supplemental information to cure the deficiencies as described in the October 27, 2021 memorandum of Patricia Garcia. Order No. 4 also stated that should Edinburg not make such a filing, this docket may be dismissed under 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 22.181(d)(6) for failure to prosecute. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. MOTION TO DISMISS WITHOUT PREJUDICE

As noted above, Order No. 4 directed Edinburg to make a filing to cure deficiencies described in Ms. Garcia's October 27, 2021 memorandum. As of the date of this filing Edinburg has made no such filing. Accordingly, the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas respectfully recommends that this docket be dismissed without prejudice for failure to amend an application such that it is sufficient after repeated determinations that the application is insufficient under 16 TAC 22.181(d)(6).

II. CONCLUSION

Based on the foregoing discussion, Staff respectfully requests that an order be issued dismissing the application without prejudice.
