COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

On September 27, 2021, the City of Edinburg (Edinburg) filed an application to amend its certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Hidalgo. Edinburg seeks approval to decertify a portion of North Alamo Water Supply Corporation's water CCN No. 10553 and amend to Edinburg's CCN No. 12106.

On November 2, 2021, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 2, establishing a deadline of January 4, 2022 for the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to file supplemental comments on the administrative completeness of the application and proposed notice and to propose a procedural schedule for the further processing of this docket. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

Pursuant to 16 TAC § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. To date, Edinburgh has not filed the required supplemental information. Accordingly, Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order requiring Edinburgh to cure the deficiencies described in the October 27, 2021 memorandum of Patricia Garcia by February 4, 2022 and extending the deadline for Staff to file comments on the administrative completeness of the application and proposed notice and propose a procedural schedule to March 4, 2022.

II. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order consistent with the above request for extension.
