**FINDING APPLICATION, AS SUPPLEMENTED, ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE,
REQUIRING NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the September 27, 2021 application of Wylie Northeast Special Utility District to amend its sewer certificate of convenience and necessity number 21056 in Collin County. On January 6 and March 2 and 9, 2022, Wylie Northeast filed supplements to the application.

On April 8, 2022, Commission Staff filed its second supplemental recommendation on administrative completeness of the application.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application, as supplemented, administratively complete and directs Wylie Northeast to provide notice of the application as described in the April 8, 2022 memorandum of Jolie Mathis using the forms attached to Commission Staff's recommendation of the same date.

The ALJ adopts the following procedural schedule:

Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice and propose a procedural schedule	May 20, 2022
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued
