COMES NOW, Aqua Texas, Inc., d/b/a Aqua Texas (Aqua or Applicant) and files this Request for Extension. In support thereof, Aqua shows the following.


On November 29, 2021, the presiding Honorable Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) issued Order No. 3 which established procedural deadlines for this matter.¹ That order set a deadline for the parties to file joint proposed findings of fact and conclusion of law on February 14, 2022.²

Aqua has conferred with Commission Staff and there are some details about Commission Staff’s recommendation that warrant further discussion between the parties. Therefore, Aqua and Commission Staff respectfully request a three-week extension of their February 14, 2022 deadline. This would make joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law due March 7, 2022. The parties respectfully request the ALJ issue an order modifying this procedural deadline accordingly.


