**SUPPLEMENT TO PETITION
TO CONFIRM PUC STAFF’S ACREAGE CALCULATIONS**

TO THE PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION OF TEXAS:

The City of New Boston, Texas (“City”) and Central Bowie County Water Supply Corporation (“Central Bowie County WSC”) (collectively, “Petitioners”) file this Supplement to Petition to Confirm PUC Staff’s Acreage Calculations (“Supplement”).

This Supplement is filed in response to Order No. 7, in which the administrative law judge determined that the Petition was administratively incomplete for the reasons described in the April 7, 2022 memorandum of Jolie Mathis (the “Staff Memorandum”). Order No. 7 set a deadline of May 9, 2022 for Petitioners to supplement the Petition to respond to the deficiencies described in the Staff Memorandum. This Supplement is timely filed.

I. CONFIRMATION OF STAFF’S ACREAGE CALCULATIONS

The Staff Memorandum requires Petitioners to submit written documentation stating if Staff’s acreage calculations for each portion of the requested area as listed below are accurate using the digital mapping data (calculated using state plan zone coordinate system). Staff’s acreage calculations are as follows:

- *Requested Area for City of New Boston (CCN No. 13164):*
 - Portions to be Transferred to CCN No. 13164 includes [RA 1A, 1B, 3, 7] = 2,288 acres
 - Add Dual Certification to CCN No. 13164 includes [RA 4] = 6 acres
- *Requested Area for Central Bowie WSC (CCN No. 10525):*
 - Portions to be Transferred to CCN No. 10525 includes [RA 2 and 6] = 56 acres
 - Add Dual Certification to CCN No. 10525 includes [RA 5 and 8] = 713 acres
- Total acreage for the requested areas includes approximately: 3,063 acres

Petitioners confirm that Staff's acreage calculations are accurate.

II. CONCLUSION AND PRAYER

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, Petitioners respectfully request that: (i) this Supplement be deemed properly filed with the Commission; (ii) the Commission approve the Contract as provided under TWC § 13.248 and 16 TAC § 24.253; (iii) the Commission enter an order transferring the Area to be Transferred to the City CCN and the Area to be Transferred to the Central Bowie County WSC CCN as requested by Petitioners; (iv) the Commission enter an order designating the Dual Certification Areas as requested by Petitioners; and (v) all other orders, acts, procedures and relief be granted as necessary to enforce the Contract.
