ORDER NO. 9
FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE AND NOTICE
SUFFICIENT, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the September 27, 2021 application of the City of New Boston and Central Bowie County Water Supply Corporation for approval of a service-area contract under Texas Water Code § 13.248 and to amend water certificates of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Bowie County. On June 28, 2022 Commission Staff filed its supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application and proposed procedural schedule.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application administratively complete. Further, the ALJ finds that the petitioners have satisfied the notice requirements of 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.253(c) and that no further notice is required.

The ALJ adopts the following procedural schedule:

Deadline for the applicants to file signed consent forms with the Commission	September 6, 2022
If no hearing is requested, deadline for Staff to file a final recommendation on the application	September 13, 2022
If no hearing is requested, deadline for the parties to file joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law	September 28, 2022
