This Report was prepared by Texas Municipal Power Agency to comply with PUCT Project No. 52667 regarding the Filing of Attestations Demonstrating Compliance with HB 4150.

Lakes Listed in PURA § 38.004(b) crossed by lines operated by City of Garland Gibbons Creek

Texas Municipal Power Agency ("TMPA") is a transmission only, municipally owned electric utility having transmission lines in several areas of the State of Texas.

- a. A declaration that each distribution line above 1 kilovolt or transmission line above 60 kilovolts owned by the utility that crosses a lake listed in PURA § 38.004(b) meets the applicable vertical clearance requirements established in Rule 232 of the NESC Standard ANSI (c)(2).***

TMPA does not own or operate any distribution lines which operate above 1 kilovolt which cross any of the lakes listed in PURA §38.004(b).

TMPA owns one double-circuit transmission line above 60 kilovolts that cross lakes listed in PURA §38.004(b). Both circuits of this transmission line meets the vertical clearance requirements established in Rule 232 of the NESC Standard ANSI (c)(2).

- b. The date on which the company verified each line's compliance with the applicable NESC Standard.***

The two circuits of the double-circuit transmission line that cross lakes are identified and were surveyed on the dates below to determine compliance with the vertical clearance requirements established in Rule 232 of the NESC Standard ANSI (c)(2).

Gibbons Creek to Singleton, Circuit 1 345 kV line –crossing Gibbons Creek
Surveyed on November 4, 2021 and determined to be in compliance

Gibbons Creek to Singleton, Circuit 2 345 kV line – crossing Gibbons Creek
Surveyed on November 4, 2021 and determined to be in compliance

- c. For each utility that self-identified a line that did not meet vertical clearance requirements in an annual report filed in either Project No. 50596 or Project No. 51890, a declaration that each line identified in the annual report meets the NESC Standard.**

Not applicable. As TMPA stated in its 2019 annual report filed in Project No. 50596 and its 2020 annual report filed in Project No. 51890, TMPA did not self-identify any lines that did not meet vertical clearance requirements of the NESC on the reporting date.

- d. If a line over a lake listed in PURA § 38.004(b) does not meet the NESC Standard:**

- Texas Municipal Power Agency, is a municipal electric utility having transmission lines in several areas of the State of Texas.
- Texas Municipal Power Agency does not own any distribution lines the cross a lake identified in PURA § 38.004(b).
- Texas Municipal Power Agency owns one double circuit transmission line that cross lakes identified in PURA § 38.004(b).
- All lines crossing a lake listed in PURA § 38.004(b) meet the applicable vertical clearance requirements established in Rule 232 of the NESC Standard 232 ANSI (c)(2).
- Texas Municipal Power Agency did not self-identify any distribution line or transmission line that did not meet the vertical clearance report in either Project 50596 or Project No. 51890.

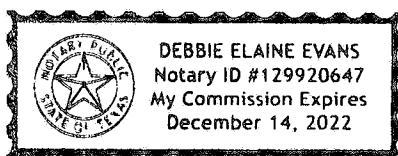


