Re: New Second Circuit from San Miguel to Palmito

## Commissioner Cobos:

Per your request, Electric Transmission Texas, LLC (ETT) is providing additional information relating to the double-circuit 345-kV transmission lines that run from San Miguel to Palmito with one circuit currently installed at most locations. As previously indicated, ETT does not need an additional certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) to construct the additional circuit on its portion of the project. The electric utilities involved in these transmission line CCN applications filed for the approval of a 345-kV double-circuit transmission line with one circuit initially installed in PUC Docket Nos. 33033, 40728, and 41606 and the Commission approved all three CCN applications.
