**ORDER NO. 2
FINDING PETITION DEFICIENT, REQUIRING ADDITIONAL NOTICE, AND
ADOPTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the sufficiency of AEP Texas, Inc., CenterPoint Energy Houston Electric, LLC, and Texas-New Mexico Company’s October 8, 2021 petition requesting the approval of interim load management programs for nonresidential customers and for an accounting order. On October 20, 2021, Commission Staff filed its recommendation on the petition, notice, and proposed procedural schedule.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the petition and proposed notice deficient. The ALJ directs the applicants to: (1) provide comprehensive details regarding the proposed interim load management program for nonresidential customers; (2) provide notice via e-mail to every participant in the last base rate case of each applicant; (3) file proof of e-mailed notice; and (4) file a proposed notice for publication in the *Texas Register*.
