ORDER NO. 5
GRANTING EXTENSION REQUEST AND DENYING COMMISSION STAFF'S
MOTION TO DISMISS

This Order addresses the March 18, 2022 request for an opportunity to cure filed by Rosendo L. Garcia, Isabel R. Garcia, and Nicholas R. Garcia. The petitioners state that they have been working with the Commission's mapping department to submit the required mapping in the correct manner and format. The petitioners are essentially asking for an extension of the deadline to cure the deficiencies in their petition, but they do not state how much additional time they need. In any future motions, the petitioners must, in accordance with 16 Texas Administrative Code § 22.77(a), state the specific relief they seek.

The administrative law judge grants the motion. The petitioners must cure the deficiencies in the petition by April 4, 2022. Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation on administrative completeness by May 4, 2022.

In light of the petitioners' apparent effort to cure the deficiencies, Commission Staff's motion to dismiss is denied. Commission Staff is free to re-urge the motion at a later date if it believes circumstances warrant.
