ORDER NO. 2
FINDING PETITION ADMINISTRATIVELY
INCOMPLETE AND NOTICE SUFFICIENT, AND PROVIDING OPPORTUNITY TO
CURE

This Order addresses the October 12, 2021 petition of Rosendo L. Garcia, Isabel R. Garcia, and Nicholas R. Garcia to amend Aqua Water Supply Corporation's certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Bastrop County by streamlined expedited release. On November 12, 2021, Commission Staff filed its recommendation on the administrative completeness of the petition.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the petition administratively incomplete for the reasons described in the memorandum of Jolie Mathis, attached to Commission Staff's recommendation. The ALJ finds notice sufficient.
