## ORDER NO. 4 FINDING PETITION REMAINS ADMINISTRATIVELY INCOMPLETE AND PROVIDING DEADLINE TO RESPOND TO MOTION TO DISMISS

This Order addresses the October 12, 2021 petition of Rosendo L. Garcia, Isabel R. Garcia, and Nicholas R. Garcia to amend Aqua Water Supply Corporation's certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Bastrop County by streamlined expedited release. In Order No. 3 filed on January 19, 2022, the administrative law judge (ALJ) found, for the second time, that the petition was administratively incomplete, and ordered the petitioners to cure the deficiencies by February 14, 2022. The petitioners did not respond to Order No. 3.

The ALJ finds that the petition remains administratively incomplete for the reasons described in the memorandum of Jolie Mathis, attached to Commission Staff's November 12, 2021 recommendation. The ALJ notes that the petitioners have never attempted to cure the deficiencies in the petition.

On March 16, 2022, Commission Staff filed a motion to dismiss the petition. Any response to the motion to dismiss must be filed by the petitioners by April 5, 2022.
