ORDER NO. 4 FINDING PETITION, AS SUPPLEMENTED, ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE AND NOTICE SUFFICIENT, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the October 12, 2021 petition of Firmitas Investments, LLC to amend Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority's water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Comal County by streamlined expedited release. On October 18, Firmitas filed supplemental filings in the docket.

I. Finding Application, as Supplemented, Administratively Complete and Notice Sufficient

On January 5, 2022, Commission Staff recommended that the petition, as supplemented, be found administratively complete and that the notice be found sufficient. The administrative law judge finds the petition, as supplemented, administratively complete and notice sufficient.

II. Establishing Procedural Schedule

Under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.2541, the granting of streamlined expedited release initiates an appraisal process to determine the amount of monetary compensation that may be owed by the landowner to the certificate holder for the tract of land that was released. Therefore, an order granting approval for streamlined expedited release is interim in nature and, in the event the requested release is approved, the docket will continue for the purpose of determining the issue of compensation.
