**ORDER NO. 2**  
**FINDING APPLICATION REMAINS DEFICIENT, ESTABLISHING**  
**DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**


This Order addresses the sufficiency of the October 12, 2021 petition filed by Firmitas Investments, LLC for streamlined expedited release from Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority's sewer certificate of convenience and necessity in Comal County. On October 19, 2021, Firmitas filed supplemental information. On November 12, 2021 Commission Staff filed its recommendation on the administrative completeness of the petition.

The administrative law judge finds the petition remains administratively incomplete, for the reasons described in Commission Staff's recommendation, and the memorandum of Pai Liu dated November 8, 2021, attached thereto.

By December 3, 2021, the petitioner must file information to cure the deficiencies. By January 6, 2022, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation on sufficiency of the petition and the sufficiency of notice, and propose a procedural schedule.
