FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the notice provided by RJR Water Company, Inc. and CSWR-Texas Utility Operating Company, LLC, regarding the application for sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Parker and Palo Pinto counties.

On December 2, 2021, the applicants filed the affidavit of Aaron Silas, regulatory case manager for CSWR-Texas Utility Operating Company, attesting that notice was provided to current customers, neighboring utilities, and affected parties, along with a map of the affected area, on November 30, 2021. On December 3, 2021, the applicants filed, confidentially, the name and address of every person and entity to which notice was provided.


The administrative law judge finds the notice sufficient.

The following procedural schedule applies for continued processing:

Deadline for intervention	December 20, 2021
Deadline for Commission Staff to request a hearing or file a recommendation on the approval of the sale and CCN amendment	January 27, 2022
Deadline for parties to file a response to Commission Staff's recommendation on approval of the sale and CCN amendment	February 10, 2022
If no response is filed, deadline for the parties and Commission Staff to file a joint motion to admit evidence and proposed notice of approval approving sale and allowing transaction to proceed	March 1, 2022
120-day deadline for the Commission to approve the sale or require a hearing	March 30, 2022
