GRANTING EXTENSION AND AMENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses Commission’s Staff’s January 27, 2022 request to extend the time to request a hearing or file a recommendation on the approval of the sale and CCN amendment. Commission Staff states that additional time is needed to review Quality Hill Partners, LLC’s motion to intervene and request for contested case hearing, which remains pending, and review the allegations made against the applicants in the intervention request.

The administrative law judge grants Commission Staff’s request for extension.

The following amended procedural schedule applies for continued processing:

If no response is filed, deadline for the parties and Commission Staff to file a joint motion to admit evidence and proposed notice of approval approving sale and allowing transaction to proceed	March 18, 2022
120-day deadline for the Commission to approve the sale or require a hearing	March 30, 2022
