**GRANTING JOINT EXTENSION AND REVISING DEADLINE**


This Order addresses Commission Staff's January 12, 2024 joint request, on behalf of itself and all parties, to extend the time to file a joint motion to admit evidence and proposed notice of approval. Commission Staff states that additional time is needed to confer with applicants on additional tariff issues and because Commission Staff is contemplating a change to the process in how tariffs are handled in these types of proceedings in which CSWR-Texas Utility Operating, LLC is an applicant.

The administrative law judge grants Commission Staff's joint request for extension.

By January 19, 2024, the parties must jointly move for the admission of relevant filings as evidence in the record of this proceeding and provide a proposed notice of approval having proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law, and ordering paragraphs.
