ORDER NO. 9 GRANTING EXTENSION AND WITHDRAWING FINDING OF ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS

By motion filed March 10, 2022, Sater, LP asks that it be given until March 22, 2022 to file a reply to Marilee Special Utility District's response to the petition. Sater explains that it will file an amended petition, including amended mapping. Commission Staff and Marilee SUD are unopposed to the request.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) grants Sater's request. By March 22, 2022, Sater must file its amended petition.

In light of the fact that Sater will be filing an amended petition with revised acreage, the ALJ withdraws his previous finding, in Order No. 6, that the petition is administratively complete. A new finding of administrative completeness will have to be made in the future. Moreover, the procedural schedule adopted in Order No. 6 is no longer in effect.

By April 22, 2022, Commission Staff must file a recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the amended application.
