ORDER NO. 4 FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING SCHEDULE FOR CONTINUED PROCESSING

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the notice provided by Iron Hill Water Supply Corporation and Rusk Rural Water Supply Corporation. The applicants filed affidavits attesting that notice was mailed to all neighboring utilities and affected parties using the notice forms provided by Commission Staff and the maps deemed sufficient. On February 25, 2022, Commission Staff filed a recommendation regarding the sufficiency of notice.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the notice sufficient.
