**COMMISSION STAFF’S RECOMMENDATION ON ADMINISTRATIVE
COMPLETENESS AND PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

On October 27, 2021, Iron Hill Water Supply Corporation (Iron Hill WSC) and Rusk Rural Water Supply Corporation (Rusk Rural WSC) (jointly, Applicants) filed an application for approval of the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) rights in Cherokee County. Applicants seek approval to sell and transfer all of Rusk Rural WSC’s certificated area under CCN No. 10785 to Iron Hill WSC. The application reflects a requested area of 2,080 acres and 155 customers. Applicants filed supplemental information on November 15, 2021.

On October 28, 2021, the administrative law judge filed Order No. 1, directing the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to file a recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application and propose a procedural schedule by November 29, 2021. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS

Staff has reviewed the application and supplemental information and, as detailed in the attached memorandum by Fred Bednarski of the Rate Regulation Division, recommends that the application be found administratively incomplete at this time. Staff recommends that Applicants be ordered to cure the deficiencies identified in the attached memorandum by December 29, 2021, and that Staff be given a deadline of January 12, 2022, to file a supplemental recommendation on the administrative completeness of the application. Staff notes that Applicants should not issue notice until the application is found administratively complete.

II. PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

In accordance with Staff's deficiency recommendation, Staff does not propose a procedural schedule for further processing of the docket at this time. Staff intends to propose a procedural schedule alongside a subsequent recommendation that the application be found administratively complete.

III. CONCLUSION

For the reasons detailed above, Staff recommends that the application be found administratively incomplete, that the Applicants be ordered to file supplemental information to cure the deficiencies in the application by December 29, 2021, and that Staff be given a deadline of January 12, 2022, to file a supplemental recommendation on the administrative completeness of the application. Staff respectfully requests an order consistent with these recommendations.

On October 27, 2021, Iron Hill Water Supply Corporation (Iron Hill WSC) and Rusk Rural Water Supply Corporation filed an application for the sale and transfer of facilities and certificate rights in Cherokee County under the provisions of Texas Water Code § 13.301 and 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.239.

2. Iron Hill WSC's most recent year-end financial statements.
