# **COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION**

On October 28, 2021, Royal Valley Utilities, Inc. (Royal Valley) filed an application under 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.25(b)(2) for approval of a pass-through rate change for an increase in the fees billed by the North Fort Bend Water Authority (NFBWA). Royal Valley filed additional information on November 5, 2021 and December 21, 2021.

On March 14, 2022, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 6 establishing a deadline of April 1, 2022, for the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to file a joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

# I. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Staff requires more time to prepare the joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law for this case. Therefore, Staff respectfully requests an extension of time until April 14, 2022, for parties to file a joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law
