ORDER NO. 3 FINDING PETITION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE AND NOTICE SUFFICIENT, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the petition and notice filed by Petrus Investment, L.P. to amend Aqua Texas Inc.'s certificate of convenience and necessity in Denton County by streamlined expedited release.

Finding Application Administratively Complete and Notice Sufficient

On February 8, 2022, Commission Staff recommended that the petition be found administratively complete and notice sufficient. The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the petition administratively complete and notice sufficient.

II. Establishing Procedural Schedule

Under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.2541, the granting of streamlined expedited release initiates an appraisal process to determine the amount of monetary compensation that may be owed by the landowner to the certificate holder for the tract of land that was released. Therefore, an order granting approval for streamlined expedited release is interim in nature and, in the event the requested release is approved, the docket will continue for the purpose of determining the issue of compensation.
