ORDER REQUESTING LISTS OF ISSUES

On November 8, 2021, Conroe Resort Utilities, LLC, and Undine Texas, LLC and Undine Texas Environmental, LLC filed an application for sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Montgomery County.

The Commission may issue a preliminary order that will contain a list of the issues to be addressed in this docket, as well as any necessary statement of Commission policy, precedent, or position on any threshold legal or policy issues relevant to this proceeding. To assist the Commission in drafting that order, Conroe Resort Utilities, LLC and Undine Texas, LLC, and Undine Texas Environmental, LLC must, and Commission Staff and any other interested party may, file in this docket a list of issues to be addressed in the docket by **June 7, 2023**. This pleading may also identify any issues that should not be addressed in the docket and identify any threshold legal and policy issues that should be briefed for purposes of a preliminary order. Specific explanations shall support any issues not to be addressed or threshold issues identified in the pleading. Parties shall not file responses to any pleading submitted in response to this Order, unless specifically requested.

If the Commission issues a preliminary order, it will provide a list of issues and areas that must be addressed in this proceeding and any necessary statement of Commission policy, precedent, or position on threshold issues, or combination thereof, relevant to this proceeding. The Commission may consider and possibly adopt a preliminary order in this docket at a future open meeting.
