UNDINE’S RESPONSE TO COMMISSION STAFF’S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

On February 23, 2022, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 3 requiring Commission Staff to request a hearing or file a final recommendation on approval of the sale and CCN amendment by March 17, 2022. On the date of the deadline, Commission staff requested an extension of its March 17, 2022 deadline to April 14, 2022, an approximately one month delay in the proceedings. Undine objects to the request for extension.

The ALJ issued Order No. 4 on March 1, 2022 requesting clarification regarding letters sent in opposition to the application. Order No. 4 established a March 15, 2022 deadline for the submittal of those clarifications. No clarifications were submitted. Accordingly, no new information has been presented to Commission Staff that would establish good cause for a month delay in the issuing its recommendation. It is important to the applicants that this proceeding move forward as expeditiously as possible. A one-month delay will create hardship on the applicants. Accordingly, Undine respectfully requests that the ALJ deny Commission Staff’s request, or, in the alternative, that the ALJ limit the delay requested by Commission Staff to a reasonable period of time.
