# COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION ON ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS, NOTICE, AND PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On November 8, 2021, Conroe Resort Utilities, LLC (Conroe) and Undine Development, LLC (Undine) (jointly, Applicants) filed an application for approval of the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) rights in Montgomery County. Applicants seek approval to acquire facilities and to transfer all of Conroe's water and sewer service area under water CCN No. 11942 and sewer CCN No. 20638 to Undine. The application reflects a requested area of 282 acres and 294 water customer connections and 289 sewer customer connections. Applicants filed supplemental information on November 9, 2021.

On November 12, 2021, the administrative law judge filed Order No. 1, directing the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to file a recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application and propose a procedural schedule by December 8, 2021. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

### I. ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS

Staff has reviewed the application and, as detailed in the attached memoranda from Jolie Mathis of the Commission's Infrastructure Division and Kathryn Eiland and Fred Bednarski of the Rate Regulation Division, recommends that the application be found administratively complete. Staff's recommendation on administrative completeness is not a comment on the merits of the application.

#### II. NOTICE

At this time, Staff recommends that Applicants proceed with providing public notice to all current customers, neighboring utilities, political subdivisions, and other persons listed in Ms. Mathis' attached memorandum using the attached notice form. Along with each individual notice, Staff recommends that Applicants provide an accurate map delineating the requested service area.

Once notice has been provided, Staff recommends that Applicants file proof of notice as described in Ms. Mathis' attached memorandum, including an affidavit specifying the name and address of every person and entity to whom notice was provided, the date that the notice was provided, and a copy of the map provided with the notice. Finally, Staff recommends that Applicants use the attached notice and affidavit to meet these requirements.

#### III. PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Staff recommends that the application be found administratively complete; therefore, Staff proposes the following procedural schedule:

#### IV. CONCLUSION

For the reasons detailed above, Staff recommends that the application be found administratively complete, that Applicants be directed to provide notice as described in the attached memorandum, and that the proposed procedural schedule be adopted. Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order consistent with these recommendations.

On November 8, 2021, Undine Development, LLC (Undine) and the Conroe Resort Utilities, LLC (Conroe Resort) (collectively Applicants) filed an application for sale, transfer, or merger (STM) of facilities and certificate rights in Montgomery County, Texas, under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.301 and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.239.

Specifically, Undine, water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 12407 and sewer CCN No. 20948, seeks approval to acquire facilities and to transfer all of the water and sewer service area from Conroe Resort under water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 11942 and sewer CCN No. 20638.

The requested area includes 294 water customer connections, 289 sewer customer connections, and includes approximately 282 acres of transferred area from Conroe Resort Utilities, LLC (CCN Nos. 11942 and 20638) to Undine Development, LLC (CCN Nos. 12407 and 20948).

The application proposes the subtraction of approximately 282 acres from Conroe Resort Utilities, LLC (CCN Nos. 11942 and 20638). The application proposes the addition of approximately 282 acres to Undine Development, LLC (CCN Nos. 12407 and 20948).

Based on the mapping review by Tracy Montes, Infrastructure Division, maps submitted with Item 1 on November 8, 2021 are sufficient. Based on my technical and managerial review of the information filed, I recommend that the application be deemed administratively complete. I further recommend that the Applicants be ordered to do the following:

1) Provide notice of the application by first-class mail to the following:

- a. Cities, districts, and neighboring retail public utilities providing the same utility service whose corporate boundaries or certificated service area are located within two miles from the outer boundary of the requested area:
