ORDER NO. 4 FINDING APPLICATION INSUFFICIENT

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the November 15, 2021 application of Conroe Resort Utilities, LLC for approval of a proposed pass-through rate change related to San Jacinto River Authority's gallonage charge, effective November 1, 2021.

On March 14, 2022, Commission Staff filed a supplemental recommendation on the application. Conroe has failed to file supplemental information as ordered by the administrative law judge (ALJ) in Orders No. 2 and 3.

The ALJ continues to find the application insufficient and directs the applicant to cure the deficiencies as described in the December 15, 2021 memorandum of Maxine Gilford, attached to Commission Staff's recommendation. Further, the ALJ notes that Conroe Resort may be required to re-notice to customers depending on the responses to the deficiencies.

The ALJ establishes the following procedural schedule for continued processing:
