I am not complaining about the sale of the water for our little subdivision. What I have a problem with is the fact that our water bill will now double. I have lived here 24 years and have had to buy drinking water the entire time I have lived here.

The water is just horrible. I had to get a special filter for my shower when I let my hair go gray because the water was turning it orange. The water has also ruined 4 water heaters and 2 washers and 2 dishwashers since we have lived here. I cannot get a refrigerator with a water and ice dispenser since the water is not drinkable. We have received forms from them stating there is a high lead content to the water. Also the pipes bringing the water into our street are PVC used for sprinklers not water systems.

We are seniors living on a fixed income and cannot afford to have to pay double for water we can't drink. Thank you for your consideration.

has submitted an application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to amend its CCN, obtain dual certification with the Town of Little Elm's water CCN No. 11202, and to purchase all of the water facilities and to transfer water certificated service area under CCN No. 11608 in Denton County, TX from:

The sale is scheduled to take place if approved by the Commission (Texas Water Code § 13.301). The transaction and the transfer of the CCN includes the following subdivisions:

East Ponder Estates and Hilltown Addition.

The requested area overlaps the district boundaries of the Upper Trinity Regional Water District. If Upper Trinity Regional Water District does not request a public hearing, the Commission shall determine that the district is consenting to the Undine Texas, LLC's request to provide retail water utility service in the requested area.

East Ponder Estates:

The requested area includes <u>109</u> current customers, is located approximately <u>8</u> mile(s) <u>southwest</u> of downtown <u>Denton</u>, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by <u>H Lively Road</u>; on the east by <u>Ed Robson Boulevard</u>; on the south by <u>a line approximately .25 mile south of Seaborn Road</u>; and on the west by <u>Florance Road</u>.

The requested area includes approximately $\underline{453}$ acres, comprised of $\underline{453}$ acres of transferred area from Terra Southwest, Inc. (CCN No. 11608).

Hilltown Addition:

The requested area includes <u>758</u> current customers, is located approximately <u>9</u> mile(s) <u>east-southeast</u> of downtown <u>Denton</u>, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by <u>Martingale Trail and Shahan Prairie Road</u>; on the east by <u>Shahan Prairie Road</u> and <u>Lewisville Lake</u>; on the south by <u>Lewisville Lake and FM 710</u> and on the west by <u>Lewisville Lake and Yacht Club Road</u>.

The requested area includes approximately 886.4 acres, comprised of:

0.4 acres of uncertificated area;

868 acres of transferred area from Terra Southwest, Inc. (CCN No. 11608); and

18 acres of dual certificated area with Town of Little Elm (CCN No. 11202).

The result of the application will be the addition of approximately 1,339.4 acres to Undine Texas, LLC (CCN No. 13260) and the subtraction of approximately 1,321 acres from Terra Southwest, Inc. (CCN No. 11608).

Approximately <u>1,321.4</u> acres will be single certification with Undine Texas, LLC (CCN No. 13260); and <u>18</u> acres will be dual certification between Undine Texas, LLC (CCN No. 13260) and the Town of Little Elm (CCN No. 11202).

The proposed transaction may change the current customers' rates and services to the current approved rates and services of Undine Texas, LLC (in tariff as Rate Year 3 effective August 1, 2022), which are higher than the current rate for a 5/8" meter for Terra Southwest, Inc. Persons who wish to intervene in the proceeding or comment upon action sought should contact the Public Utility Commission, P.O. Box 13326, Austin, Texas 78711-3326, or call the Public Utility Commission at (512) 936-7120 or (888) 782-8477. Hearing- and speech-impaired individuals with text telephones (TTY) may contact the commission at (512) 936-7136. The deadline for intervention in the proceeding is (30 days from the mailing or publication of notice, whichever occurs later, unless otherwise provided by the presiding officer). You must send a letter requesting intervention to the commission which is received by that date. The letter must include the person's name, address, email address and fax number if applicable.

If a valid public hearing is requested, the Commission will forward the application to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a hearing. If no settlement is reached and an evidentiary hearing is held, SOAH will submit a recommendation to the Commission for final decision. An evidentiary hearing is a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.

A landowner with a tract of land at least 25 acres or more, that is partially or wholly located within the requested area, may file a written request with the Commission to be excluded from the requested area ("opt out") within (30) days from the date that notice was provided by the Utility. All opt out requests must include a large-scale map, a metes and bounds description of the landowner's tract of land, landowner's name, address, email address and fax number, if applicable.

In addition, the landowner must also send a copy of the opt out request to the Utility. Staff may request additional information regarding your request.
