COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION ON CLOSING DOCUMENTS AND PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On November 16, 2021, Terra Southwest, Inc. and Undine Development, LLC (Undine) (collectively, the Applicants) filed an application for approval of the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Denton County under the provisions of Texas Water Code § 13.301 and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.239. On August 26, 2022, the application was supplemented to replace Undine Development, LLC with Undine Texas, LLC (Undine).

On July 12, 2023, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 30, directing the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas to file a recommendation regarding the sufficiency of the Applicants' closing documents and to propose a procedural schedule within 15 days of the closing documents being filed. On August 4, 2023, the Applicants filed notice of the completed transaction and evidence of closing. Fifteen days from August 4, 2023, is August 21, 2023. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. RECOMMENDATION ON THE SUFFICIENCY OF THE CLOSING DOCUMENTS

Staff has reviewed the closing documents and documentation regarding customer deposits filed by Applicants and recommends that Applicants have met the requirements of 16 TAC § 24.239.

Specifically, the sale and transfer was completed following the issuance of Order No. 30, wherein the transferee received notice from the Commission that a hearing would not be requested. Further, the closing documents were filed within 30 days after the effective date of the transaction and were signed by both the transferor and the transferee. Therefore, Staff

recommends a finding that Applicants' closing documents are sufficient and satisfy 16 TAC § 24.239(a), (i), and (l).

Regarding customer deposits, both the original and supplemental application state that there are no customers with deposits held by the transferee in the transferred service area.³ Furthermore, in Applicants' closing documentation, the Applicants submitted a notarized affidavit stating that there are no outstanding customer deposits associated with this transaction.⁴ Therefore, Staff recommends a finding that customer deposits have been adequately addressed as required by 16 TAC § 24.239(k) and (l).

For these reasons, Staff recommends that the Applicants have complied with the requirements provided by 16 TAC § 24.239. Staff recommends a finding that the closing documents and documentation regarding customer deposits be found sufficient.

II. PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Staff recommends that the application be found administratively complete. Therefore, Staff proposes the following procedural schedule:
