FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE,
REQUIRING NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of November 16, 2021 application of Terra Southwest, Inc. and Undine Development, LLC for the proposed sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Denton County. The applicants filed supplemental information on November 17, 19, and 22 and December 13, 2021. On January 18, 2022, Commission Staff filed a recommendation of the sufficiency the application.


The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application administratively complete and directs the applicants to provide notice of the application and proof of notice in the manner described in and attached to Patricia Garcia's memoranda dated January 14, 2022, using the included forms.

The ALJ adopts the following procedural schedule:

Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice	February 28, 2022
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued
