ORDER NO. 6 FINDING NOTICE DEFICIENT

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the notice provided by Terra Southwest, Inc. and Undine Development, LLC for the proposed sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Denton County.

On February 3 and 17, 2022, the applicants filed proof of notice. On February 28, 2022, Commission Staff filed a recommendation on the sufficiency of notice.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the notice deficient for the reasons described in the February 28, 2022 memorandum of Patricia Garcia attached to Commission Staff's sufficiency recommendation of the same date. The ALJ amends the procedural schedule as follows:

Deadline for the applicants to file with the Commission signed affidavits that the notice was given along with a copy of the notice and map sent to the affected parties	March 10, 2022
Deadline for the applicants to file proof that notice was published in a newspaper having general circulation in Denton County once each week for two consecutive weeks	April 1, 2022
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice	March 24, 2022
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued
