ORDER NO. 7 FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the notice provided by Terra Southwest, Inc. and Undine Development, LLC for the proposed sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Denton County.

On February 3, 2022, the applicants filed the affidavit of Carey A. Thomas, senior vice president for Undine Development, attesting that notice was mailed to current customers, neighboring utilities, and affected parties on February 1, 2022. Attached to the affidavit were copies of the notice and map provided by the applicants. On March 14, 2022, the applicants filed a publisher's affidavit attesting that notice was published in the *Denton Record-Chronicle*, a newspaper of general circulation in Denton County, on March 6 and 13, 2022. The applicants filed copies of the published notice on March 14 and 22, 2022.

On March 24, 2022, Commission Staff filed its recommendation on the sufficiency of the notice.

The administrative law judge finds the notice sufficient and establishes the following procedural schedule for continued processing of this docket:
