COMMISSION STAFF'S STATUS REPORT

On November 16, 2021, Terra Southwest, Inc. (Terra) and Undine Development, LLC (Undine), (collectively, Applicants), filed an application for approval of the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) rights in Denton County.

On August 9, 2022, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 14 requiring the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) and Applicants (collectively, Parties) to file a joint status report, or separate reports as necessary, regarding the proper processing of this docket by August 15, 2022. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. STATUS UPDATE

Staff believes the parties have reached an agreement in principle on this docket, and Staff continues to work with Applicants to implement said settlement. Staff expects to file a recommendation on further processing of the docket soon. In the interest of maintaining a procedural schedule in this docket, Staff proposes filing its recommendation, another status report, or requesting a hearing in this docket by August 31, 2022.

II. CONCLUSION

For the reasons detailed above, Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order consistent with this recommendation.
