**ORDER NO. 3
REQUIRING COMMISSION STAFF FINAL RECOMMENDATION ON THE MERITS**

In this matter, AEP Texas Inc. seeks authorization to conduct a non-standard true-up to adjust its Rider TC-3 rates for each customer class. AEP Texas and Commission Staff are the only parties to this proceeding. The parties have filed a joint motion to admit evidence and a proposed order approving the application.

Before the application can be approved, the administrative law judge (ALJ) requires a substantive analysis and recommendation on the application by Commission Staff. By January 28, 2022, Commission Staff must file a final recommendation on the merits of the application, including addressing whether the adjustments requested by AEP were properly calculated in compliance with the financing order in Docket No. 39931.¹

Because Commission Staff will be filing a recommendation on the merits, it is possible that the parties may wish to have that recommendation admitted as evidence. For this reason, the ALJ declines to rule on the joint motion to admit evidence filed by the parties on January 14, 2022. The parties must file a new motion to admit evidence by February 4, 2022.
