ORDER NO. 2
FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE,
REQUIRING NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the November 22, 2021 application of Carroll Water Company, Inc. and CSWR-Texas Utility Operating Company, LLC for sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Ellis County. The applicants filed supplemental information on November 23, 2021 and December 7, 2021. On December 22, 2021, Commission Staff filed a recommendation of the sufficiency the application.


The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application administratively complete and directs the applicants to provide notice of the application and proof of notice in the manner described in and attached to Patricia Garcia's memoranda dated December 2, 2021, using the included forms.

The ALJ adopts the following procedural schedule:

Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice	February 7, 2022
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued
