The sale is scheduled to take place if approved by the Commission (Texas Water Code § 13.301). The transaction and the transfer of the CCN includes the following subdivisions:

Emerald Forest:

The requested area includes <u>63</u> customer connections, is located approximately <u>7</u> miles <u>west</u> of downtown <u>Waxahachie</u>, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by <u>Angus Road</u>; on the east by <u>Perimeter Road</u>; on the south by <u>FM 1446</u>; and on the west by <u>D Ranch Road</u>.

The requested area includes approximately <u>226</u> acres, comprised of <u>226</u> acres of transferred area (from CCN No. 11543) that would remain dual certificated with Buena Vista-Bethel SUD (CCN No. 10898).

Grande Casa:

The requested area includes <u>167</u> customer connections, is located approximately <u>8</u> miles <u>southwest</u> of downtown <u>Waxahachie</u>, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by <u>FM 66</u>; on the east by <u>Alysa Road and Industrial Road</u>; on the south by <u>Greathouse Road</u>; and on the west by <u>Greathouse Road</u>.

The requested area includes approximately <u>805</u> acres, comprised of <u>805</u> acres of transferred area (from CCN No. 11543) that would remain dual certificated with Buena Vista-Bethel SUD (CCN No. 10898).

Lakeview Ranchettes:

The requested area includes <u>106</u> customer connections, is located approximately <u>3</u> miles <u>west</u> of downtown <u>Midlothian</u>, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by <u>Old Fort Worth Road</u>; on the east by <u>N Ward Road</u>; on the south by <u>W Wyatt Road</u>; and on the west by <u>Miller Road and Soil Conservation Service Site 9 Reservoir</u>.

The requested area includes approximately <u>529</u> acres, comprised of <u>529</u> acres of transferred area (from CCN No. 11543) that would remain dual certificated with City of Midlothian (CCN No. 11706).

Red Oak:

The requested area includes <u>112</u> customer connections, is located approximately <u>2</u> miles <u>northwest</u> of downtown <u>Red Oak</u>, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by <u>Ovilla Road</u>; on the east by <u>I-35 E</u>; on the south by <u>Baldwin Street</u>; and on the west by <u>Overlook Drive</u>.

The requested area includes approximately <u>61</u> acres, comprised of <u>61</u> acres of transferred area (from CCN No. 11543) that would remain dual certificated with City of Red Oak (CCN No. 11074).

Spanish Grant:

The requested area includes <u>111</u> customer connections, is located approximately <u>9</u> miles <u>west-southwest</u> of downtown <u>Waxahachie</u>, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by <u>Old Buena Vista Road</u>; on the east by <u>Alto Road</u>; on the south by <u>El Camino Road</u>; and on the west by <u>Mesa Road</u>.

The requested area includes approximately <u>47</u> acres, comprised of <u>47</u> acres of transferred area (from CCN No. 11543) that would remain dual certificated with Buena Vista-Bethel SUD (CCN No. 10898).

Totals:

The application proposes the transfer of approximately <u>1,668</u> acres from CCN No. 11543 to CCN No. 13290. Approximately <u>1,078</u> acres would remain dual certificated with Buena Vista-Bethel SUD (CCN No. 10898). Approximately <u>529</u> acres would remain dual certificated with City of Midlothian (CCN No. 11706). Approximately <u>61</u> acres would remain dual certificated with City of Red Oak (CCN No. 11074).

This transaction will not have an effect on the current customer's rates and services.

Hearing- and speech-impaired individuals with text telephones (TTY) may contact the commission at (512) 936-7136. The deadline for intervention in the proceeding is (30 days from the mailing or publication of notice, whichever occurs later, unless otherwise provided by the presiding officer). You must send a letter

requesting intervention to the commission which is received by that date. The letter must include the person's name, address, email address and fax number if applicable.

If a valid public hearing is requested, the Commission will forward the application to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a hearing. If no settlement is reached and an evidentiary hearing is held, SOAH will submit a recommendation to the Commission for final decision. An evidentiary hearing is a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.

A landowner with a tract of land at least 25 acres or more, that is partially or wholly located within the requested area, may file a written request with the Commission to be excluded from the requested area ("opt out") within (30) days from the date that notice was provided by the Utility. All opt out requests must include a large-scale map, a metes and bounds description of the landowner's tract of land, landowner's name, address, email address and fax number, if applicable.






CCN - 11543 Small Map Emerald Forest, Grande Casa, Spanish Grant





CCN - 11543 Small Scale Map Lakeview




CCN - 11543 Small Scale Map Red Oak








CCN - 11543 Large Scale Map Emerald Forest Page 10 of 12





CCN - 11543 Large Scale Map Red Oak


